CALIFORNIA TO REQUIRE SOLAR ENERGY IN NEW HOMES



Most homes as of 2020 will be required to include solar panels, following the standards adopted by the California Energy Commission.

The measure highlights the difference in concept. Before, only luxury homes had this ecological orientation.

The state has long been at the forefront of energy policy, started with setting energy efficiency standards for home appliances.

The US had 10.4 gigawatts of residential solar power at the end of last year, more than six times as many as five years ago. There is no doubt in the future trend.

The adoption of these standards represents a tremendous advance in state building standards, with gains for all.
